Online Lesson Responsible Usage Agreement for Parents

This agreement outlines the conditions, which apply to our online lessons being delivered to further enhance our provision.

This should be read alongside the Online Lessons Responsible usage Agreement for Students that outlines the parameters to which all students are expected to adhere, in order to engage safely in online sessions.

Students are expected to read and discuss this responsible user agreement with you, and then to follow the terms of the agreement.

To facilitate the delivery of online lessons during school suspension, parents should support students by:

- providing children with a workspace that is quiet, safe and free from distractions with an adult nearby if necessary
- making sure students are dressed appropriately (school uniform is not necessary)
- ensuring that face-to-face communication is only between teachers and students, any parent to teacher communication should be in the usual manner via email.

Parents may not record, share or comment on public forums about individual teachers.

Before allowing your child to log on, you must accept this agreement and acknowledge that you have shared this document and discussed the Online Lesson Responsible Usage agreement for Students with your child. It is vital that your child agrees to follow the rules.
